

Proposal by Denmark in respect of Faroe Islands and Greenland
for a Recommendation on Conservation and Management Measures for Mackerel in the NEAFC
Regulatory Area for 2022

The Commission hereby adopts the following Recommendation pursuant to Article 5 of the Convention:

1. NEAFC notes that, as Coastal States to the management of the mackerel stock, the Faroe Islands, the European Union, Greenland, Iceland, Norway and the United Kingdom have agreed that the ICES MSY advice of 794 920 tonnes should represent the level of catches of mackerel in the North-East Atlantic for 2022.
2. Each Contracting Party shall establish conservation and management measures for its mackerel fishery in the NEAFC Regulatory Area for 2022.
3. Conservation and management measures shall include catch limits.
4. Only vessels entitled to fly the flag of a NEAFC Contracting Party, having been authorised by relevant authorities to fish for mackerel in the NEAFC Regulatory Area, may take part in the fishery.
5. Each Contracting Party shall notify the conservation and management measures it has taken to the Secretary by 1 May 2022. The Secretary shall without delay notify these measures to the other Contracting Parties.
6. These conservation and management measures shall be without prejudice to any future conservation and management measures to be taken for the mackerel in the North-East Atlantic.
