1. This determination sets fishing opportunities for British fishing boats for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks. These include:
 - a) the maximum quantity of sea fish that may be caught by British fishing boats; and
 - b) the maximum number of days that British fishing boats may spend at sea.
2. This determination sets fishing opportunities for British fishing boats that may only be caught in United Kingdom (“UK”), European Union, Norwegian, Svalbard and international waters.
3. The Secretary of State makes this determination under section 23 of the Fisheries Act 2020 for the purpose of complying with the UK’s international obligations to determine the UK’s fishing opportunities, including under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea.
4. Unless otherwise stated, this determination sets British fishing opportunities from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022 inclusive.
5. This determination is presented to Parliament by the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs by Command of her Majesty.
